

# CAPITAL CITY FIESTA MEXICAN-AMERICAN BOWLING TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The Capital City Fiesta Mexican-American Bowling Tournament is open to any male or female bowler certified by the USBC.
2. United States Bowling Congress rules and regulations will govern the Tournament. Capital City Fiesta Mexican-American is USBC certified.
3. All participants must have in their possession a current USBC membership card. Eligibility for those without a current USBC card may be established with the purchase of an associate USBC membership card for \$21.00. Participation fee of \$5.00 may be purchased for this tournament only.
4. Cash prizes in every event will be determined on a handicap basis. Prize ratio 1 of 8 in every event.
5. Handicap is 80% of 220 scratch. Entrants must use their highest United States Bowling Congress sanctioned average of at least 21 games for 2008-2009 or current season average with a minimum of 21 games or more as of June 1, 2010.
6. Those without an average will be accepted on the basis of a 180 average; handicap will be computed from a minimum individual average of 150.
7. USBC Rule 319A3, Accuracy of avg., will be enforced. Be familiar with USBC Rule 319E.
8. All averages must be certified by your City Association Secretary or Association previous season's year-book.
9. Reserved entries close Sunday, July 4, at midnight. Entries close July 10, 2010 at 1:00 p.m.
10. No Entry will be accepted unless accompanied by complete Entry Fee.
11. No Entry Fee can be returned after reserved entries close. USBC Rule 314
12. No change in five-man event will be allowed unless substitution is involved and if so, changes must be made one hour before scheduled time to bowl. No changes will be allowed in the singles event.
13. Entrants may bowl only once in Singles and Doubles. Team Event may be bowled twice with no more than three members of the original team bowling together. First score bowled shall count towards all-events. USBC Rule 315
14. Entry blanks must be completed showing all dates required.
15. Original Score Sheets are official, and any obvious errors are subject to change and correction by the Tournament Committee. Protests of error in scoring or calculations must be made in writing to the Tournament Committee prior to payment of prizes.
16. Bowlers need not report previous tournament winnings. USBC Rule 319D.
17. In case of mechanical failure, bowlers may be moved to next available pair of lanes.
18. Tardy players will start in frame being bowled with a zero given for frames missed.
19. Lane assignments will be made by the Tournament Committee. Singles will be bowled first, followed by Doubles.
20. The Tournament Director reserves the right to change shift preference.
21. Team Captains must report to Tournament Office at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled time of bowling.
22. Fees must be paid by Certified Check, Credit Card or Money Order. No personal checks will be accepted.
